Llano Estacado Pinot Grigio is a very popular Texas wine. Cold fermentation and a special strain of yeast combine to accentuate the fruity characteristics of aroma and bouquet. There is no oak used in the production of this wine, here we chose to showcase the aromatic characteristics of the variety.

2017 Pinot Grigio is made from Pinot Grigio (75%) grown on the Texas High Plains (Reddy and Newsom Vineyards), Texas Sauvignon Blanc 16%, Riesling 5% and Albariño 4%.

Pinot Grigio is a fragrant wine with fresh, fruit aromas of melon, lemon-grapefruit. This wine is perfect when served as an appetizer or reception wine.

Pinot Grigio is an excellent aromatic food friendly white wine, that's perfect with lighter cuisine or sip by the glass.
