THP Sangiovese was created by winemakers that believe in the magic of blended wines. Sangiovese is a blend of 2 varieties; Sangiovese 85% and Cabernet Sauvignon 15%. The grapes are from 2 important growers on the Texas High Plains, Vijay Reddy of Brownfield and Neal Newsom of Plains, Texas.

Deep red in color, this wine has perfumed-complex ripe aromatics of plum, and is medium bodied with rich, lush, expansive tannins. The Cabernet Sauvignon contributes to the firm tannins. This wine will age gracefully through 2017.

Wine and food is a natural match, being that this wine originated from grapes grown on the Texas High Plains, try Sangiovese with your favorite cut of beef, or savor with lamb Crown Rib Roast, and always pairs well with most Italian dishes with a red sauce. Salute!!
