The Dell Valley in Far West Texas has a longstanding reputation of excellence for the agricultural products grown there. Mont Sec's beginnings spring from grapes grown in the Dell Valley beneath Guadalupe Peak.

Mont Sec Viognier is made from 99% Viognier grown on the Mont Sec Vineyard and 1% Roussanne grown on the Reddy Vineyard on the Texas High Plains. Viognier is recognized as a noble variety in France where it is extensively grown in the Rhone district. The Viognier grapevine has adapted well to our sun-drenched Texas climate producing moderate yields of high quality grapes.

Viognier is a wonderful change of pace and lighter on the palate than Chardonnay. This is a medium bodied wine, true to the character of the variety. Viognier is a fine accompaniment to seafood, veal and poultry dishes. Serve slightly chilled.
