Llano Estacado Pinot Grigio has become a very popular wine. Cold fermentation and a special strain of yeast combine to accentuate the fruity characteristics of aroma and bouquet. There is no oak used in the production of this wine, as we chose to showcase the aromatic characteristics, and fresh, beautiful fruit of the variety.

2015 Pinot Grigio was made from Pinot Grigio grapes grown on the Texas High Plains (Reddy Vineyards) and Sauvignon Blanc from Far West Texas (Mont Sec Vineyard). It is a blend of 81% Pinot Grigio and 19% Sauvignon Blanc.

Pinot Grigio is a fragrant wine with fresh, fruit aromas of melon, lemon-grapefruit. This wine is perfect when served as an appetizer or reception wine.

We recommend this wine to be served with all types of seafood, salads, and poultry. Pinot Grigio is also an excellent aromatic white wine to enjoy by the glass.
