This 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of several Texas vineyards including Mont Sec in Far West Texas and Patel and Burkett on the Texas High Plains. It's composition of 81% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Petit Verdot, and 2% Sangiovese is sure to please. We barrel aged this wine at the winery for two years to help smooth out the tannic structure making it approachable now. The beginning bright fruit aromas change over to more complex flavors of cinnamon and leather.

This beautiful wine will continue to improve and benefit from extended bottle aging.
