The Llano Estacado 2009 Sauvignon Blanc was made from Sauvignon Blanc grapes grown predominantly at the Mont Sec Vineyard in far west Texas. This is a crisp, dry white wine with hints of delicate fruit on its nose and palate.

This dry wine complements Oriental foods, chicken dishes, seafood, cold soups or pasta dishes. It pairs especially well with Italian herbs and spices such as oregano, rosemary, sage, dill, anise seed, and with many salads with an Italian style dressing.
