Llano Estacado Winery has produced Shiraz for nine vintages now. When first released in 2001, it was made entirely from our Texas fruit. In order to meet the overwhelming demand that has developed over the years, we have had to bring in wine from California (Central Coast AVA) and Washington State (Columbia Valley AVA) to blend with our Texas Shiraz.

Shiraz is an ancient variety of the Mediterranean, originating in the south of France where it is known as Syrah. Llano Shiraz is made in a style that accentuates the berry fruit flavor components that naturally occur in the grape. This style was made popular by the Australian wine industry where it is known as Shiraz.

This wine has a lush palate and is packed with blackberry aromas, rich soft tannins and a smooth finish.

We encourage a glass of wine with your meal, and we hope you enjoy this one. Try it with barbecued baby back ribs, or your favorite pizza.
