Malvasia Bianca is a white variety thought to be a native of Greece but also grown extensively in Southern Italy.

Llano Malvasia Bianca was crafted from grapes grown near Deming, New Mexico. The arid Southwest climate of Deming creates a perfumed wine with floral aromas of Honey Suckle and Orange Blossoms. This aromatic wine is balanced naturally with citrus-papaya flavors. Our Winemakers arrested the fermentation to provide for residual natural sugar that enhances the mouth feel. Then, this wine was fortified with wine spirits to achieve a dessert wine we hope you enjoy.
