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Our 2010 Texas Merlot is a blend of 98.7% Merlot, from the Newsom Vineyard in Plains, Texas and 1.3% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Mont Sec Vineyard located in far West Texas.

This wine has a complex bouquet as a result of the extended barrel aging showing hints of dried cranberries and cherries. Our Reserve Merlot has a medium body and is rich in flavor. Reserve Merlot is perfect on its own or with a variety of foods including Texas meats and ribs and pork tenderloin.

Serve our 2010 Llano Estacado Cellar Reserve Merlot at a cool room temperature (58-70F).
