Our 2010 Texas Merlot is a blend of 82% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 7% Malbec. The Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon was made from grapes grown on the Mont Sec Vineyard in far West Texas, the Malbec from the Newsom Vineyard of Plains, Texas. This wine possesses softer tannins with a bouquet displaying notes of red berries, plums and prunes. Full in flavor, Merlot is perfect on its own or with a variety of meals. Serve Merlot at a cool room temperature (58-70F) with meat and pasta dishes. Enjoy!
