Sangiovese is a grape variety famously grown throughout Italy. Our 2011 Wine Club Sangiovese was grown locally by the Reddy Vineyards in Brownfield, TX. We've been working with Vijay Reddy on a number of small-batch wines for the last few years, so expect to see future Wine Club varieties coming from his vineyard.

This light bodied red wine remains true to the variety with its perfumed, floral aromas. Elements of strawberry, black cherry and plum follow into the mouth. The light texture of this wine lends itself to be paired with a variety of Southwest and Italian dishes.
