Our 2013 Cellar Reserve Tempranillo was made from Tempranillo 91% and 9% Mourvèdre. Due to spring frost in 2013 there was low grape crop production in Texas. The Tempranillo is a blend between Texas and Paso Robles, CA. The Mourvèdre is from the Texas High Plains.

This wine possesses rich tannins with a bouquet displaying notes of red berries, plums, and Spanish cedar. Full in flavor, this Cellar Reserve Tempranillo is perfect on its own or with a variety of meals. Try it in place of a Cabernet with Brisket and other Beef dishes; Wild game, or hearty Pastas.
