The Dell Valley in Far West Texas has a longstanding reputation of excellence for the agricultural products grown there. Mont Sec's beginnings spring from grapes grown in the Dell Valley beneath Guadalupe Peak.

Mont Sec Gewürztraminer is 97% Gewürztraminer from the Mont Sec Vineyard and 3% Gewürztraminer from Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo County, California.

Gewürztraminer is a variety with a pink to red skin color, which makes it an odd "white wine grape". This wine is off-dry, with a flamboyant bouquet of lychee nut and nutmeg spice.

Serve slightly chilled, Gewürztraminer's delicate fruit sweetness complements the spice in Asian cuisine.
