The Dell Valley in Far West Texas has a longstanding reputation of excellence for the agricultural products grown there. Mont Sec's beginnings spring from grapes grown in the Dell Valley beneath Guadalupe Peak.

Mont Sec Viognier is made from 100% Viognier grown on the Mont Sec Vineyard. Viognier is recognized as a noble variety in France where it is extensively grown in the Rhone district. The Viognier grapevine has adapted well to our sun drenched Texas climate producing moderate yields of high quality grapes.

Viognier is lighter on the pallet than Chardonnay. This is a medium bodied wine true to the character of the variety. Viognier is a fine accompaniment to seafood, veal and poultry dishes. Serve slightly chilled.
