Our 2020 vintage of 1836 Red wine is a blend of 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 19% Syrah, and 5% Alicante Bouchet all sourced from West Texas. Good extraction during fermentation and sur lie aging in 100% new oak allowed us to create a rich yet balanced red wine.

This wine pours a deep purple/red color, and contains extraordinary fruit extraction that includes red currant, black cherry, coconut crème, with hints of black pepper and spice. Textured mouthfeel and a lengthy finish await the first sip of this structured and bold wine.

This is a perfect wine to enjoy with your favorite cut of steak, or aged cheddar cheeses.
