VARIETY: 97% Sauvignon Blanc, 3% Albariño

WINE MAKING: The 2022 Harvest Sauvignon Blanc from Llano Estacado Winery, crafted exclusively for H-E-B, was designed to showcase the vibrant character of Texas-grown Sauvignon Blanc. Fermented in stainless steel to preserve freshness, this wine reveals bright notes of grapefruit, lime, and tropical fruits, complemented by a hint of green apple and herbs. Its crisp acidity and clean, mineral finish reflect Llano Estacado's dedication to quality and the expression of Texas terroir.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS: The 2022 Harvest Sauvignon Blanc is best served well-chilled at 45-50°F (7-10°C) to enhance its bright acidity and refreshing flavors. This light-bodied wine pairs wonderfully with seafood, green salads, goat cheese, and light pasta dishes. Its crisp, clean finish also makes it an excellent choice for enjoying on its own as a refreshing aperitif.
