Our 2015 vintage of 1836 Red wine is a blend of 53% Cabernet Sauvignon, 44% Syrah and 3% Merlot, all sourced from our best vineyards throughout Texas.

The 2015 Texas High Plains growing season and harvest was near perfect. Ample heat and dry weather allowed the vines to fully ripen and mature the varietal components of this blend, which allowed us to create a rich, yet balanced red wine.

It has a deep opaque red color, extraordinary fruit extraction that include hints of currant, black cherry, black pepper and licorice. Medium tannins add to a lush, lengthy finish. Enjoy it with your favorite cut of steak and a rich peppercorn sauce.
