THP Sangiovese was created by winemakers that believe in the magic of blended wines. This blend is composed entirely of Texas High Plains grapes, fermented as separate parcels and blended to achieve a balanced and complex wine.

This fruity wine has ripe aromatics of ripe cherry, fresh herbs, and with just a kiss of toasty oak. This wine is light bodied with refreshing acidity and soft tannins.

Our THP blends were intended to be enjoyed at the dinner table. These varieties come together to create a savory effect when paired with food.
