Winemaker's Reserve Red Blend

VARIETIES:	Malbec (55%), Tempranillo (15%), Petite Sirah (14%) Barbera (6%), Petit Verdot (5%), Alicante Bouschet (5%)

OAKING:	Aged 9 months in 225-Liter French oak barrels (50% were new) sourced from Demptos Cooperage. Finished in 15 gallon, charred Bourbon barrels for 90 days.

Our Winemaker's Reserve Red Blend represents a unique and flavorful experience. After 8 months of aging in 225-Liter French oak wine barrels, this bold Red Blend spent 3 extra months in 55-gallon Bourbon barrels soaking up the intense flavor of the charred wood.

This Red Blend has traditional wine aromas of dark cherries as well as subtle tones of spice and black pepper. The Bourbon barrels provide a sweet nose of mocha, butterscotch, toasted walnut, with lingering notes of caramel and vanilla. Indulge in the creation of this exclusive Texas wine. Enjoy with dark chocolate or sharp, hard cheeses.
