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Viviano has a 16-year pedigree as one of the highest quality red wines. Texas has to offer. The numerous Gold and Silver medals in National and International wine competitions support this claim.

Our 2008 Texas Viviano is a blend of 73.2% Cabernet Sauvignon from the vineyards of Rising Star Vineyard and, 19.7% Sangiovese from Newsom Vineyard, with Syrah, Malbec, Petite Verdot and Cabernet Franc to round out the blend.

Focus here is on complex aromatics from extended barrel aging. Aromatics also include layers of mocha, dried cherries and cedar. Serve Viviano with Texas beef tenderloin or rib-eye. Serve at a cool room temperature of (58-70°F)
