The Llano Estacado Winery Wine Club is a perfect venue for us to showcase small, handcrafted batches of wine. In addition, we get the opportunity to bring recognition to the Llano Growers whose hard work allows us to make these special lots.

Aglianico is a red grape variety grown primarily in the southern Italian regions of Campania and Basilicata. Like our 2011 Wine Club Sangiovese, this 2011 Aglianico was grown locally by the Reddy Vineyards in Brownfield, TX. This medium bodied red wine contains bold flavors of blackberry and black plum. The ample tannin in this wine makes it a perfect choice for a juicy rib-eye steak.

If you were around for the Wine Club pick up party in November of 2011, this was the wine we tasted out of barrels. Unfortunately, we were only able to make 2 barrels (just under 120 gallons) of this Aglianico in 2011. This is a rare one that will benefit from a few years in the bottle. However, I think we will be sold out of it long before then.
