The Dell Valley in Far West Texas has a longstanding reputation of excellence for the agricultural products grown there. Mont Sec's beginnings spring from grapes grown in the Dell Valley beneath Guadalupe Peak.

Mont Sec Sauvignon Blanc is 98% Sauvignon Blanc from the Mont Sec Vineyard and 2% Sauvignon Blanc from the San Lucas Vineyard, in Monterey County, California.

Made using New Zealand protocols this Sauvignon Blanc is crisp and clean. Enjoy refreshing hints of Key lime pie and citrus zest, lemongrass in the mouth and a light mineral finish.

Serve slightly chilled with salads and lighter sea food, such as shrimp, scallops, and tilapia.
