Llano Estacado Winery has produced Shiraz for 10 years now. When first released in 2001 it was made entirely from our Texas fruit. In order to meet the overwhelming demand that has developed over the years we have brought wine in from California (Central Coast AVA) and Washington State (Columbia Valley AVA) to blend with our Texas Shiraz.

Shiraz is an ancient variety of the Mediterranean with its longest history in the south of France where it is known as Syrah. Llano Shiraz is made in a style that accentuates the berry fruit flavor components that naturally occur in the grape. This style was made popular by the Australian wine industry where it is known as Shiraz.

This wine has a lush pallet and is packed with blackberry aromas, rich soft tannins and a smooth finish.
