

Winemaker's Notes

VARIETY:	Cabernet Sauvignon
VINTAGE:	2018
APPELLATION:	Texas High Plains Lilli of the Vine Vineyard
ALCOHOL:	14.6%
OAKING:	82% new French oak puncheon 18% neutral oak barrel



The purpose of this dual release is to focus on a wine's "sense of place", which is known in the wine industry as the concept of "terroir". This concept can be defined as the encompassing environment, including soil, climate, and topography which are key components in determining the final taste of the wine. The two wines presented are 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, grown within the 1,000,000+ acre Texas High Plains AVA!

The wine exhibits a ruby/garnet color of average depth, with the edges starting to show a light brickish hue. Deep red fruited aromatics with rich, milk chocolate scents intertwined. Soft textured tannins but with some palate weight to let you know it's Cabernet Sauvignon.
