The 2018 Petite Grange emulates the bold yet balanced Shiraz/Cabernet blends coming from our friends in "Oz". 24 months of aging in oak barrels yields ripe yet complex aromatics and flavors. Simply put, this wine blends the approachability of an aged Cabernet Sauvignon and the classiness of Syrah. This mature red will delight on its own or at the dinner table. We recommend serving this wine with grilled red meats, bbq/brisket, and aged cheeses.
