VARIETY:	Roussanne
VINTAGE:	2019
VINEYARD:	One Way Vineyard

OAKING:	Partially fermented in French oak; aged in French oak 500-L "puncheons" for 7 months



The Llano Estacado wine club is a perfect venue for us to showcase small, handcrafted batches of wine. In addition, we get the opportunity to bring recognition to the Llano Growers whose hard work allows us to make these special lots.

This 100% Roussanne is made from grapes sourced from the One Way Vineyard located in the Texas High Plains AVA.

The grapes were harvested mid-September at full maturity and ripeness for maximum flavor and texture. The grapes were gently pressed into 500-L American Oak barrels (called a "puncheon") for fermentation. After 7 months of "sur lie" aging in the same barrels they were fermented in, the Roussanne was bottled. This wine is dry and full bodied with peach tea aromas, followed by honey and tropical fruit flavors. A rich texture allows this wine to be paired with a variety of meals from roasted chicken or pork to cream based pastas, as well as hard and soft cheeses.
