OAKING/Aging:	Aged sur-lee for 9 months in stainless steel tanks



A grape native to northern Portugal and NW Spain that is now successfully grown in West Texas! Castano Prado Vineyard is an "urban" vineyard located right in the heart of the city of Brownfield, TX. It's terrior creates this very aromatic version of this variety, with aromas and texture akin to the wines made from the Viognier grape. (Tangerine, Peach, Tropical Fruits, White Flowers)

This wine is best drunk cool, with or without food, but food and wine will always taste better when paired. I would suggest Iberian cuisine like croquettes and seafood.
